

Update June 17, 2021

Our newly formed Cayman Islands Government held a press conference on Wednesday June 16th, 2021.

The Premier of the Cayman Islands announced on Wednesday that they are currently working on a phased reopening plan for the return of tourism visitors to the Cayman Islands. It was alluded to that this would begin around the middle of September. We hope over the next few weeks the full plan will be announced.

The re-opening plan for the Cayman Islands is still dependent on the Islands reaching herd immunity with the uptake of the vaccine.

Our borders and the hotel are still closed. Once we have further updates and hopefully reopening protocols, we will be able to announce a re-opening date.

<u>Sea Harvest restaurant & My bar</u> are open as normal. <u>Sunset Divers</u> is open for shore diving, teaching & occasional boat trips.
