COVID UPDATE from the Cayman Islands Government 2021

Following is a synopsis of the details released by our government regarding the phased plan for the safe reopening of the Cayman Islands. Given the information, we feel fairly confident that they will not open the borders to tourist travel until mid-October earliest. After studying the update it appears that effective October 14 (and that's if our population reaches 80% vaccinated) the government will do away with the quarantine requirement. We do not believe that requiring tourists who are only coming for a week to quarantine is an option.

Safely Reopening the Cayman Islands - Government update July 9, 2021

In a press conference the Cayman Islands government announced the details of a phased reopening plan for travelers to the Cayman Islands. Basically, the plan for safely reopening our borders is still contingent on 80% of our population being vaccinated, but we are hopeful that we will reach this level of vaccination by mid-September. If the rate of local vaccination goal is reached Phase 3 will kick in which will allow a limited introduction of tourism. If this proves successful Phase 4 will become effective October 14 in which all quarantine requirements will be removed for vaccinated travelers to allow for the safe increase in tourism and further relaxation of restrictions.

Phase 1 - Effective June 2021 - Reduced quarantine period

Phase 2 - Effective August 9, 2021 - Reduced Repatriation Restrictions

Phase 3 - Effective September 9, 2021 - Limited Introduction of Tourism

Phase 4 - Effective October 14, 2021 - Reduced Quarantine Restrictions

Phase 5 - Effective November 18, 2021 - Unvaccinated children will be allowed to travel with vaccinated adult tourists
